WOMEN suffering and/or recovering from Breast Cancer, Ovarian Cancer, and Uterine Cancer. Up to 77% of BC survivors report sexual dysfunction. 1

MEN suffering and/or recovering from Prostate Cancer. Early evaluation of ED post prostate surgery is optimal. Untreated dysfunction may lead to permanent problems. Up to 90% of prostate cancer survivors will experience ED.²
